WEBSITE PLATFORMS:


WIX:

Add an iFrame to your site directly from the Add panel. You can choose between an **HTML iFrame** where you enter a code snippet, or **Embed a Site** if you want to embed a website address into the iFrame.

To add an HTML iFrame:

1. Click **Add**  at the top left of the Editor
2. Click **Embed & Social**
3. Select an element to add it to the page, then follow the relevant steps below:
 - Embed Widget
 - Click **Enter Code**.
 - Paste your custom HTML code in the text box.
 - Click **Apply**.
 - Embed Site

- Click **Enter Website Address**.
- Paste the website address in the text box.
- Click **Apply**.

Using the Inspector panel  at the top right, you can control the iFrame's size and position on your page. For example, you can set fluid measurements for your iFrame so it adapts to different screen sizes. You can customize these settings separately for each of your breakpoints, if the behavior should be different.

SHOPIFY:

Adding an iFrame

- **Copy the iFrame code:** Obtain the iFrame code from the source you want to embed (e.g., a form builder, a video hosting service, or a map).
- **Access the Shopify page:** Navigate to the Shopify page where you want to embed the iFrame.
- **Enable HTML mode:** In the Shopify editor, click the <> icon to enter HTML mode.
- **Paste the iFrame code:** Paste the copied iFrame code into the HTML editor.
- **Save and preview:** Click the <> icon to exit HTML mode, then save the page. Preview the page to ensure the iFrame is displayed correctly.

SQUARESPACE:

Make sure you're logged into your Squarespace site, and select the site you want to add the iframe to (edit the site).

- In an empty section, **add a new Code block.**
- Then, edit the code block and add the iframe code to the editor:
 - `<iframe src="URL" title="Page title" height="400px" width="100%"></iframe>`
 - Add the iframe code
- Make sure to edit the URL (insert your page URL, obviously), the page title, the height, and the width.
